Luke* has lived in Bradford since Eden Futures' service opened in 2015 and receives daily support for autism and a significant learning disability.

Through his childhood, he struggled to engage in daily life and spent three years living in a secure unit after his mental health significantly deteriorated.

His mum Angela says, "The transition from child to adult services has been incredibly hard for him and we were concerned that he wouldn't be able to live in the community before we approached Eden Futures for help. Moving into his own specialist bungalow has been so important in developing a sense of independence."*

"The amount of support he requires has decreased from a 5-1 staff ratio to a 3-1 ratio over the past five years and he's now on the lowest level of psychotic medication to date. The Eden Futures team have been instrumental in getting him to this point."
