

## Doxey House, Stafford

### Community Supported Living Service

Working in partnership with Bespoke Supportive Tenancies (BeST), Eden Futures brings to the sector eleven single person apartments in Stafford.

The service is primarily to provide a step-down from Mental Health Hospitals for both mental health and learning disability service users.



#### Accommodation

The flats are spacious and specially equipped with expert maintenance to ensure safe and quality environments. There are fully equipped shared kitchens available, and each apartment has its own kitchenette. Ground floor flats have extra width doorways and wet room bathroom facilities.



Each one-bedroom apartment has its own entrance and spacious living area comprising of a lounge, dining room and kitchenette.

The service has the benefit of an additional staffing area to enable us to provide an umbrella of support that includes a waking night as an integral part of the support package.

The service and environment are designed to support and encourage people to gain more independence and to take part in their local community. Support levels can be flexible to meet people's changing needs as their independence increases.

A range of support systems, equipment and assistive technologies can be provided to maximise each person's independence. Secure parking is available.

That Stafford staff team are supported by our Behavioural Specialist Team to ensure that all new service users have a positive transition in to their new her. The Behavioural Support Team promote person centred service delivery and take the lead on regulatory issues and joint working with other agencies.

## Location

The service is situated in the Quiet village of Doxey, with easy access to Stafford town centre by bus, for local amenities and shops. There are excellent transport links for getting around Stafford, the surrounding areas and the rest of the UK.
